The seats will be assigned by the KC Chiefs and will be in the upper level between the goal line and the 30 yard line. **These seats normally sell for \$60 to \$78.**

There is no maximum for the number of tickets purchased and no refunds. Payment may be made by check to GARY KRINGS, 5525 NEOSHO LANE, FAIRWAY, KS 66205, or **pay by credit card on the Guild's website**, www.tntguild.org.

Here's how it works:

1. You indicate which game(s) you wish to attend,
2. Make a check made payable to NTSG for \$45 per ticket (parking is NOT included),

When your payment is received, we will notify the Chiefs with your name and email address, and they will contact you to arrange for you to get your tickets.
